2022 TechFIN received more In attention than at any point in its history. Spotlights through the John A Reisenbach Foundation's Dear New York television production, which aired multiple times on FOX, CBS, ABC and NBC, in addition to a piece produced by NY1's Lori Chung, raised the profile of TechFIN to new heights. The coverage has widened our pipeline

corporate hardware donors and monetary donors. TechFIN is proud to have deployed 901 computers to low-income families in the New York City metropolitan area in 2022, but we have the potential to deploy several thousand in a calendar year. With the help of our existing and future corporate hardware and financial supporters, we intend to make that happen.

The high cost of computer hardware is one of the key reasons the digital divide persists today. Computers should be as commonplace in the home as kitchen appliances. TechFIN believes that redirecting unwanted corporate PCs from the scrapheap into deserving homes is the most cost-effective way of accomplishing this at scale. TechFIN can procure a working computer for a deserving family at an all-inclusive cost of \$120 per computer.

We thank our monetary donors and the many corporations who have donated machines and partnered with us to reduce the e-waste from their upgrade cycles. Their efforts have directly benefited the lives of thousands simply by making the choice to allow their hardware to have a second life.

OUR STORY

TechFIN was founded in 2013 by Shadan Deleveaux and Frankson. It officially earned its 501(c)(3) designation in 2014. Both co-founders grew up in without homes computer hardware, and as result, struggled to play catchup upon enrolling in college where all assignments are assigned, completed and submitted digitally. Both men subsequently entered the work force quickly noticed they received new computers every two to three corporations would vears, as rather prematurely upgrade workstation than risk employee downtime due to malfunction. The stark juxtaposition between their resource restricted upbringing and their resource rich careers sparked the notion that there had to be some way to redirect these working computers from the scrap heap to the living room.

OUR MISSION

TechFIN aspires to help narrow the digital divide by addressing a major hurdle to computer hardware ownership: its cost. By collecting used PC based laptop and desktop computers, in bulk, from corporations, we are able to revitalize these machines and distribute them to low-income households at no cost to them. Our solution is sustainable, scalable and cost effective

In 2022 TechFIN had its most productive year yet. Although we fell short of our goal of 1000 computers donated, due to the uneven nature of hardware availability, we are proud to have provided 901 families with a PC.

~16K LBS OF E-WASTE DIVERTED


Thanks to our corporate donors TechFIN successfully divert over 16 thousand pounds of e-waste from landfill by simply choosing to give their hardware a second life.


