# MESSAGE FROM OUR FOUNDER



It's with great gratification I say this for the second year in a row: 2024 was a banner year for TechFIN on the fundraising front. Our 2024 goal was to raise enough funding to hire our first executive director, and I'm happy to report - mission accomplished!

Since the publication of our last annual report, TechFIN won grants from **Reisenbach Philanthropies** for the 3rd year in a row and Epoch Investment Partners for the 2nd year in a row. TechFIN is a first time winner of grants from **Rumphius Foundation, AEO Better World Foundation, Community Offshore Wind and New York Urban League**. Most of these have not funded yet. On January 8th of this year, TechFIN was announced as a winner of Brooklyn Org's 2025 Spark Award. It is the largest grant award in our history.

The soon-to-be hired executive director will have two primary mandates: growing and maintaining

our relationships with corporate hardware donors and leading the charge on fundraising. With the right individual

in place, TechFIN will grow from an organization that aspires to donate 1,000 computers per year to one that aims to provide upwards of 5,000 computers per year to low-income families in Brooklyn and its sister boroughs. With your support, I'm confident we will get there.

# OUR STORY

TechFIN was founded in 2013 by Shadan Deleveaux and Nigel Frankson. It officially earned its 501(c)(3) designation in 2014. Both co-founders grew up in homes without computer hardware and as a result, struggled to play catchup upon enrolling in college where all assignments are assigned, completed and submitted digitally. Both men subsequently entered the work force and quickly noticed they received new computers every two to three years, as corporations would rather prematurely upgrade a workstation than risk employee downtime due to malfunction. The stark juxtaposition between their resource-restricted upbringing and their resource-rich careers sparked the notion that there had to be some way to redirect these working computers from the scrap heap to the living room.



# OUR MISSION

TechFIN is narrowing the digital divide by addressing a major hurdle to computer hardware ownership: its cost. By collecting used PC based laptop and desktop computers, in bulk, from corporations, we are able to revitalize these machines and distribute them to low-income households at no cost to them. Our solution is sustainable, scalable and cost effective

# SPOTLIGHT: ANTOINE SIMONS

Antoine joined TechFIN in 2015 and immediately added much needed IT expertise to the board. We knew donated computers would require some TLC prior to finding a new home, and Antoine could tell us exactly what that TLC entails. For the past decade Antoine has hired and trained all of our technicians, overseen their work and helped the organization manage external expectations. He makes the call



on what hardware we revitalize versus what can't be salvaged. All TechFIN computers are touched by a member of his staff.

During Antoine's 20+ year career he has held leadership, consulting, and project management roles where he has developed expertise in IT infrastructure, networking, and security. He is no stranger to implementing enterprise-level migrations and integrations. Antoine possesses a Bachelor of Science in Telecommunications and a Master of Science in Cybersecurity. TechFIN, and those we serve, are lucky to have him managing our process and ensuring every TechFIN computer is ready to serve the needs of its second home.

A computer is worth far more as whole than it is as recycled scrap metal. The demand for computers in low-income communities dramatically exceeds the supply. While official city-wide statistics say 30 to 40% of low-income households do not have computers, in our experience, the numbers are closer to 80%.
